Attention all Military and Veterans, First Responders, Teachers and Paraprofessionals, and anyone else who is concerned about the impact suicide has on families and our communities. The American Legion Post 91 Family in Beebe is continuing our mission to prevent suicide in our veteran and military population along with other groups where we have seen a larger than average suicide rate.

To meet our mission, we have invited instructors from Columbia University to come to Beebe to teach their 90-minute Columbia Protocol-Suicide Severity Rating Scale (C-SSRS) to anyone interested in receiving this training. The Columbia Protocol provides suicide risk screening through a series of simple, plain language questions that anyone can ask. Attendees to this training leave prepared to respond when necessary and able to instruct others in this training.

The Columbia Lighthouse Project's mission is to light the way to ending suicide. Their message, like the Columbia Protocol itself, is simple: "Just Ask. You Can Save a Life." Use this link for more information about the Columbia protocol: <https://cssrs.columbia.edu/>

For the teachers, paraprofessionals, counselors, and students grade 9-12 and college


October 20th at 6pm in the Beebe Schools Auditorium – **Be The One** training
